

Us & Friends: Education for Everyone Participation Agreement

Hi,

We are excited and honored that you are interested in participating in one of our courses/classes or events. We wanted to take a little time to outline some basics of what to expect and what is expected in all our courses/classes and events, as well as go over some basic logistics and pragmatics.

1) Respect and Kindness

- a. Our number one expectation from all involved is respect and genuine kindness toward everyone, all the time, regardless of a bad mood we may be in or any differences we may have in world-view, ideology, religion, politics, ethnicity, race, gender, sexual orientation, socio-economic status, where we are from in the world, or any other conceivable context; as Jacky Moon says, "E.L.E. Everyone Love Everyone". All Us & Friends associates and participants are expected to abide by this.
- b. Bullying, harassment, discrimination, and similar behaviors will not be tolerated.

2) Quality and Consistency

- a. It is expected that all Us & Friends sponsored courses/classes, events, and instructors are of high quality and demonstrate consistency, to the best of our ability.
- b. Start Time—To be respectful of everyone's time and ensure that we have adequate time to meet the expectations of quality for our courses/classes and events, it is expected that all courses/classes and events start promptly at advertised times. Participants are responsible for being on time; generally, courses/classes and events will not wait for participants to arrive, and missed material will not be made up.
- c. Session Time—some of our courses/classes and events last for a duration of time that may be difficult for some participants to remain appropriately engaged in. This is part of why we have age restrictions for certain courses/classes and events. Participants are responsible for maintaining appropriate behavior throughout all courses/classes and events; parents of children are responsible for their children maintaining appropriate behavior throughout the entirety of all courses/classes and events. Parents are expected to use good judgment in realistically assessing whether their child is capable of sitting, following instructions, staying engaged, and maintaining generally acceptable behavior throughout the duration of a course/class or event. In some cases, if a participant cannot appropriately manage the full duration of time, we may be able to accommodate a "part-time" arrangement; please discuss this possibility with us if applicable.
- d. Accommodating Special Needs—Our ethos is "for everyone" to be able to participate in everything—we attempt to make our courses/classes and events as accessible as possible in every way possible. In reality, however, we are currently limited in several ways. We currently do not have the resources nor the training to sufficiently accommodate all needs—this is an area that we desire to continually progress in. All

interested participants are welcome and encouraged to try our various courses/classes and events, but it must be realized that some situations may not be workable with our current resources and training. Parents are expected to use good judgment in realistically assessing whether their child is capable of sitting, following instructions, staying engaged, and maintaining generally acceptable behavior throughout the duration of a class or event.

3) Missed or Cancelled Courses/Classes or Events

It is inevitable that at some point, a course/class or event will be forced to cancel, due to things like: no electricity, no water, no internet, closure of locations that we meet at, extreme weather, illness, etc.

- a. If Us & Friends is forced to cancel a course/class or event due to variables beyond their control, like those listed above, the classes or event will be rescheduled and made up somehow; the considerations of all participants and instructors will be taken into consideration and an attempt to accommodate all or as many as possible will be made. In general, refunds will not be made for those who cannot make the rescheduled class or event, but a refund may be appropriate in some circumstances.
- b. If Us & Friends cancels a course/class or event due to reasons within their control, full refunds will be made.
- c. If a participant cannot attend a course/class or event or decides the course/class/event is not for them (and quit), generally:
 - i. The participant will not be refunded.
 - ii. Courses/classes, events, or material will not be retaught or redone.
 - iii. Depending on the course/class or event, a recorded version and/or some extra study material or resources will be made available, but this is dependent upon the course/class or event.

4) Tuition Payments (When Applicable)

- a. Space is limited, consequently:
 - i. A deposit is required to reserve your spot. Deposits are credited toward the balance. Deposits are non-refundable.
 - ii. The full remaining balance (tuition minus deposit) is due by the first class/session and is non-refundable. We no longer offer payment plans.
 - iii. Part of the reason for our no-refund policy and the ceasing of payment plans is due to the problem that is caused when a participant reserves their spot and doesn't follow through with attendance—their spot could've been reserved (and benefited) by a participant who would've taken advantage of the opportunity; this happens too frequently and we feel it is unfair and limiting to those who take these opportunities seriously.

5) Parents

a. Parents need to remain on-site for all in-person classes and events. Parents are responsible for taking their children to the bathroom and dealing with any behavioral issues that may come up.

6) Library Rules and Protocols

- a. Us & Friends is truly thankful for the opportunity that the library, its wonderful staff, and the City of Cabo Rojo, have given us by opening up their wonderful facilities for our use. The library is intentional about promoting a familial environment and we insist that we treat all staff, guests, patrons, and the facilities with the utmost respect.
- b. All library rules, policies, and protocols must be respected and adhered to.
 - i. The library is a place of study for many, and we need to do our part to maintain an appropriate study environment for all. (See Attachment)
